Preparation requirements for your examination

General Xray	No preparation required.
Ultrasound of Abdomen or Gallbladder	Nothing to eat or drink for 6hrs before appointment.
Ultrasound of Pelvis	Please arrive with a full bladder. Drink 500mL of water, finishing 1hr before your appointment. For our female patients, an internal scan may be required.
Ultrasound of Kidneys & Bladder (Renal)	Please arrive with a full bladder. Drink 1L of water, finishing 1hr before your appointment.
Ultrasound of Early Pregnancy (up to 17 weeks)	Please arrive with a full bladder. Drink 500mL of water, finishing 1hr before your appointment.
Ultrasound Morphology (18 - 20 weeks)	Please arrive with a full bladder. Drink 500mL of water, finishing 1hr before your appointment.
CT Scan of Head, Neck, Chest or Kidneys (Urogram)	Nothing to eat or drink for 4hrs before appointment.
CT Scan of Abdomen/Pelvis	Nothing to eat or drink for 4hrs before appointment. Please arrive at rooms 1hr prior to appointment to drink oral contrast solution.
CT Scan of Spine	No preparation required.
Fluoroscopic HSG	Performed day 7 to 10 of your menstrual cycle. A urine pregnancy test will be performed prior to the examination.
Mammography	Two-piece clothing recommended. No talcum powder or deodorant. Please bring relevant previous imaging to your appointment.
Bone Mineral Densitometry	No preparation required. Please do not book your BMD examination within 1 week of having other radiological tests that require the administration of contrast.
Barium Studies	Preparation will be discussed at the time of booking.
MRI	Preparation will be discussed at time of booking.
